I wrote the majority of this record while my longtime band was slowly falling apart, I lost my job, and was approaching the end of my twenties with a hell of a lot less figured out than I had hoped.

I was lucky enough to work with some of biggest musical heroes on this record. John K Samson and I spent months going through the lyrics with a fine tooth comb. I would write a draft, send it to John, and he would mark it up with a red pen and tell me to do better. He connected me with Jason Tait (The Weakerthans, Bahamas) who spent weeks in his garage with me arranging the tunes with just drum kit and guitar before we brough in some of Winnipeg's finest such as Liam Duncan (Boy Golden), Julie Penner (Broken Social Scene), Bill Western (Del Barber, Leaf Rapids), and Madeleine Roger to finish the album.

This is the first body of music I've ever released where I can still stand to listen to the songs 2 -4 years after writing them. I hope you like it!"
